The suspension/revocation of SOUTHERN MARIN LACROSSE CLUB is based on the following violations:

- 1. Failure to file the Annual Registration Renewal Fee (Form RRF-1) Report(s), together with required renewal fee, for fiscal year(s) ending: 12/31/2011, 12/31/2012, 12/31/2013, 12/31/2014, and 12/31/2015, in violation of Government Code section 12586, subdivision (a), and California Code of Regulations, title 11, sections 301 through 306 and 311.
- 2. Failure to file IRS Form 990, 990-PF, or 990-EZ, report(s) for fiscal year(s) ending: 12/31/2011, 12/31/2012, 12/31/2013, 12/31/2014, and 12/31/2015, in violation of Government Code section 12586, subdivision (a), and California Code of Regulations, title 11, sections 301 through 305.


